Dear Mr. Leahy,

I am writing to commend you for issuing subpoenas relating to Whitehouse and NSA warrantless spying and eavesdropping efforts. I feel it is my duty to share with you information that may explain why the Executive Branch has been less than eager to depart with these documents. I possess evidence and documentation that indicates Michael Hayden has deployed implantable medical device technology as part of Defense and Intelligence operations domestically, and has done so by categorizing these highly coveted implantable sensors as "electronic listening devices". The efforts taking place under these warrantless spying efforts include technology that has not been disclosed to Congress, exceeds traditional "monitoring" and is highly unlawful. Please see the attached correspondence with Senator Dianne Feinstein and which documents the evidence, which is related and may prove useful in the investigation and inquiry into Whitehouse activities regarding this highly controversial program.

In closing, if you feel the evidence outlined in the correspondence with Senator Feinstein would be useful, or if you desire further details, I would be willing to comply with any request from the Legislative Branch and you have my full cooperation. I applaud you for your efforts and urge you to continue to demand disclosure and release of the documents you desire.
